Thank you for your interest in University of the Ozarks. This form is the primary application for admission to University of the Ozarks. Students seeking admission to the Jones Learning Center or as international students are required to submit additional application materials. These materials are available at www.ozarks.edu/application. The application process at Ozarks is a personal one. An admission counselor will work with you throughout the application and enrollment process. Our admission process identifies students who have the potential to be successful at Ozarks and who will contribute to our community in meaningful ways. We will carefully consider your application for admission, course selection, grades, test scores (if required), and level of motivation when making our decision. The admission committee may request additional materials from you if necessary to make an admission decision.

Application Deadlines

Fall Regular Application: Applications for the fall semester should be submitted by March 1 for priority consideration. The admission staff and admission committee review applications on a rolling basis beginning October 1 and begin notifying students of decisions October 15.

Spring and Summer Terms: Applications should be submitted at least one month prior to the beginning of the term.

Completing the Application for Admission

1. Print or type the application form. For your convenience, the application form can be completed on our website and submitted electronically.
2. Enclose the \$30 nonrefundable application fee. Please do not mail cash. If you apply online this fee is waived.
3. Request official transcripts from your high school and/or any colleges you have attended. If currently enrolled, please request a final transcript to be mailed after graduation or upon completion of the term. Transfer students who have completed less than 30 hours at the time of application must also submit official high school transcripts.
4. Submit official SAT or ACT scores including the writing scores. Applicants who have completed fewer than 30 semester hours of college course work must also submit official ACT or SAT scores.
5. All students are required, by the state of Arkansas, to present proof of immunization prior to attending classes.

Student Support Services

Ozarks provides equal access to all university programs for qualified students with disabilities. Any student who has a disability limiting one or more major life activities is expected to present appropriate documentation to the Liaison for Students with Disabilities or to the Director of the Jones Learning Center so steps can be taken to access reasonable accommodations. Although there is no deadline for self-identification, the student must allow time for services to be arranged; therefore, early identification is encouraged.

Jones Learning Center

The Jones Learning Center offers premium support services for an additional fee to a limited number of students with specific diagnosed learning disabilities or attention deficit disorder as a primary disability. JLC services feature a 4:1 student to staff ratio and support services which far exceed those required by law. In addition to submitting the documents required for freshman, transfer, or international admission, JLC candidates must submit a \$75 application fee, complete the application packet found on our website at www.ozarks.edu/jlc, and fulfill additional testing and interview requirements. Because of the extensive application process, students are encouraged to apply early in the senior year.

Instructions for International Students

In addition to submitting the documents required for freshman or transfer admission, international students must also submit a letter of sponsorship and certified bank statements from the sponsor demonstrating the ability to pay for at least one year of college expenses. International students whose native language is not English must submit TOEFL scores or the equivalent. All required documents must be submitted with a certified translation if the original is not in English.

Concurrent High School Enrollment

Johnson County or area residents currently enrolled as high school juniors or seniors may apply for concurrent enrollment. Students admitted to this program receive a tuition waiver for one class per semester. Please contact the Ozarks Office of Admission for additional details.

Tuition Deposit

If you are admitted to Ozarks and plan to enroll, you must submit a \$100 tuition deposit. The deposit is due by May 1 or within 30 days of admission, whichever is later. The deposit is required prior to registration for classes. The deposit may be refunded prior to May 1 if requested in writing.

Housing Deposit

In addition to the tuition deposit, a \$100 housing deposit is required for students who will live on campus. Freshman and sophomore students are required to live on campus unless living with a parent, guardian, or spouse within 50 miles of campus. The housing application and deposit are due by June 1 for best consideration.

Scholarships and Financial Aid

Students interested in receiving financial assistance must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). For best consideration, students should apply for admission and submit the FAFSA before March 1.
